She lives with her mother, a brother and three sisters in a rented, one-room brick house. Their house is not equipped with running water or a proper latrine facility. Her mother works very hard washing clothes for others to provide for her family.

Carmen attends school in Grade 6 and really enjoys it. Her favorite pastimes are singing, soccer and playing with her brothers. She hopes to study very hard and become a dentist.

Working with the “Our Lady of Fátima Parish”, their organization will work to alleviate extreme poverty conditions in Bolivian families and to empower women, children and teenagers to achieve a better quality of life.

We are very excited as a school we have the opportunity to sponsor Carmen. We have decided to put aside one day a month and call it “Quarters for Carmen”. So far our donations have helped Carmen buy clothes, shoes, school supplies, medicines and food for her family.
